

Adams-Harris Pattern Company

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This just takes a few scraps of fabric 2-10 inch squares will work. One should be for your lining. You will also need about 1/2 yard of 1/8 inch ribbon for the tie and handles. To decorate your bag, I used pom-poms on the end of the ties for the fur bag, and self stick flocked flowers on the others.

Both bags were lined in cotton.

Sewing Directions:

1. Sew the lining fabric to the top of each self fabric heart with right sides together between notches. Clip the seam allowance to the end of you stitching and V at the center of heart top.
2. Trim excess seam allowance so the top of the heart curves with turned. Turn and press the heart tops.
3. With right sides of the fashion fabric together, sew only the fashion fabric and not the lining from the clipped notch around the bottom of the heart and back to the other clipped notch. Again trim excess fabric.
4. With bag still wrong side out pull lining over raw edges of bag bottom and slip stitch closed.
5. Turn back right side out and press if fabric allows it. My faux fur, couldn't be pressed so I worked the back flat with my fingers.
6. Attach straps, at notches (mine were about 10 inches long) then attach a tie on each side of the bag at the top of the heart. Trim as wanted.
